AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE McHENRY COUNTY STORMWATER
MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, 55 ILCS 5/5-1062 grants counties authority to prescribe by ordinance
rules and regulations for floodplain and stormwater management; and,

WHEREAS, on January 20, 2004, the County Board of McHenry County, Illinois
adopted Ordinance Number 0-200401-10-009, commonly known as the McHenry County
Stormwater Management Ordinance; and,

WHEREAS it is in the public interest of the Village of Ringwood that the Village of
Ringwood adopt, by reference, the aforesaid McHenry County Ordinance No. 0-200401-
10-009, known as the McHenry County Stormwater Management Ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF
TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF RINGWOOD, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION 1. The aforesaid McHenry County Ordinance No. 0-200401-10-009,
commonly known as the McHenry County Stormwater Management Ordinance with the
modifications attached thereto as Exhibit A, B and C, be and the same is hereby adopted
by reference as and for the Stormwater Management Ordinance of the Village of
Ringwood, Illinois.

SECTION 2. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this
ordinance shall be fined not less than Twenty Five Dollars (\$25.00) nor more than Five
Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each offense committed on each day during, or on which,
a violation occurs or continues.

SECTION 3. All ordinances, or parts thereof, in conflict with the terms and provisions hereof, be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form by and under the authority of the Corporate Authorities of the Village.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.
