ORDINANCE NO. 05-2-2  
AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A GENERAL  
PENALTY FOR VIOLATIONS OF VILLAGE ORDINANCES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE  
VILLAGE OF RINGWOOD, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION 1. GENERAL PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF VILLAGE ORDINANCES.  
Whenever in any ordinance of the Village any act is prohibited or is made or declared to be unlawful or a misdemeanor, or whenever in such ordinance the doing of any act is required or the failure to do any act is declared to be unlawful or a misdemeanor, the violation of any such provision of such ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$50.00 nor more than \$750.00. Each day any violation of any provisions of any ordinance shall continue shall constitute a separate offense and shall be punishable by a separate fine.

SECTION 2. All ordinances, or parts thereof, in conflict with the terms and provisions hereof, be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form by and under the authority of the Corporate Authorities of the Village.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.
