ORDINANCE NO. 98-11-3  
AN ORDINANCE ADDING SECTION 611 TO THE  
SUBDIVISION ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE  
VILLAGE OF RINGWOOD, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Subdivision Ordinance for the Village of Ringwood, Illinois is hereby amended by adding thereto the following provision as and for Section 611 thereof:

"611. DECELERATION LANES REQUIRED ON BARNARD MILL ROAD AND RINGWOOD ROAD. Deceleration lanes shall be installed by the subdivider at all subdivision entrances on Barnard Mill Road and Ringwood Road in accordance with the minimum design requirements and construction specifications prescribed by the Village Engineer."

SECTION 2. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this ordinance shall be fined not less than Twenty Five Dollars (\$25.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each offense committed on each day during, or on which, a violation occurs or continues.

SECTION 3. All ordinances, or parts thereof, in conflict with the terms and provisions hereof, be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 5. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this ordinance shall be fined not less than Twenty Five Dollars (\$25.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each offense committed on each day during, or on which, a violation occurs or continues.

SECTION 6. All ordinances, or parts thereof, in conflict with the terms and provisions hereof, be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 7. This ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form by and under the authority of the Corporate Authorities of the Village.

SECTION 8. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.
