AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 901  
OF THE VILLAGE SUBDIVISION ORDINANCE

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OF THE VILLAGE SUBDIVISION ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE  
VILLAGE OF RINGWOOD, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 901 of the Village Subdivision Ordinance is hereby amended by increasing the present "Fair Market Value" of improved land in and surrounding the Village from \$50,000.00 per acre to \$75,000.00 per acre and also by amending the criteria for school sites to read as follows;

400 capacity Elementary Schools (grades K-5) on 15 acres of land;

750 capacity Junior High Schools (grades 6-8) on 35 acres of land;

1,000 capacity High Schools (grades 9-12) on 60 acres of land;

and,

SECTION 2. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this ordinance shall be fined not less than Twenty Five Dollars (\$25.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each offense committed on each day during, or on which, a violation occurs or continues.

SECTION 3. All ordinances, or parts thereof, in conflict with the terms and provisions hereof, be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.
