ORDINANCE NO.Ø-12- / THE ANNUAL TAX LEVY ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF RINGWOOD, ILLINOIS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING MAY 1, 2005 AND ENDING APRIL 30, 2006

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Ringwood, McHenry County, Illinois, did on the 16th day of May, 2005 pass the Annual Appropriation Ordinance for the said Village for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 2005 and ending April 30, 2006, and

WHEREAS, said Ordinance was approved by the President of the Village on the 16th day of May, 2005, the amount of which is ascertained to be the aggregate sum of one million, one hundred three thousand, and thirty five dollars (\$1,103,035.00).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF RINGWOOD, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION 1. That thereby and is hereby levied upon all of the taxable property within the corporate limits of the Village of Ringwood, Illinois, subject to taxation for the year 2005, the sum of sixty six thousand, four hundred fifty-two dollars and zero cents (\$66,452.00) for the following specific purposes designated in said Appropriation Ordinance and in the respective sums as follows:

SECTION 3. This Levy Ordinance is adopted pursuant to procedures set forth in the Illinois Municipal Code, provided, however, that any limitations in the Illinois Municipal Code in conflict with this Ordinance shall not be applicable to this Ordinance, pursuant to Section 6 of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form by and under the authority of the corporate authorities of the Village of Ringwood.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and approval and publication in pamphlet form, according to law.
