ORDINANCE NO. 07-10-1

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR
COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF WHITE GOODS

SECTION 1. Definition of "White Goods": White goods shall include all discarded refrigerators, ranges, water heaters, freezers, air conditioners, humidifiers and other similar domestic and commercial large appliances which are freon-based, including but not limited to those containing any chlorofluorocarbon refrigerant gas.

SECTION 2. No person or owner of property within the Village may cause or allow any white goods to be placed outside of any building or structure, or cause or allow the removal therefrom for disposal without first having obtained a Village permit to do so.

SECTION 3. The collection and disposal of white goods shall be performed by Enviro-Safe Appliance Recycling, Inc. pursuant to the attached agreement between the Village and Enviro-Safe, which agreement is hereby approved.

SECTION 4. After the aforesaid permit is acquired from the Village, such permittee shall be responsible for contacting Enviro-Safe to arrange for the day, time, and place of the permittee's white goods. Each permittee shall pay Enviro-Safe the fee specified on the permit for the applicable white good to be collected and disposed.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.
