**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE APPROVAL OF A PROPOSED
ANNEXATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE VILLAGE OF RINGWOOD,
MCHENRY COUNTY, ILLINOIS AND ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF
TRANSPORTATION**

WHEREAS, ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION is the record owner of a certain parcel of real estate located in Ringwood, Illinois which is legally described on the attached Exhibit "A" in McHenry Township, McHenry County, Illinois; and

WHEREAS, said real estate is contiguous to the existing corporate limits of the Village of Ringwood, McHenry County, Illinois; and

WHEREAS, notice of public hearing was published in the Northwest Herald, a newspaper of general circulation in the Village, within the time provided by law, notifying the public of a hearing on a proposed Annexation Agreement between the Village and **ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION**, to be held before the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Ringwood, McHenry County, Illinois on **March 26, 2009 at 7:30 p.m.;** and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Ringwood have held the aforesaid hearing in connection with said Annexation Agreement as required by law and have found that the entry into said Agreement will not be detrimental to the public health, welfare, or safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Ringwood, McHenry County, Illinois.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF RINGWOOD, MCHENRY COUNTY, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The Annexation Agreement by and between the Village of Ringwood, Illinois and **ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION**, be and the same is hereby approved. A complete and accurate copy of said Annexation Agreement is attached to this Ordinance and incorporated herein by reference as **Exhibit "A"**.

SECTION 2: The Village President and Village Clerk of the Village of Ringwood are hereby authorized and directed to affix their signatures as Village President and Village Clerk of said Village to said Agreement for the uses and purposes therein set forth.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage and approval as required by law.
