ORDINANCE 14-2-1

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR VOLUNTARY SETTLEMENT OF ORDINANCE
VIOLATIONS IN LIEU OF JUDICIAL PROSECUTION THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE
VILLAGE OF RINGWOOD, MCHENRY COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION 1: Voluntary Settlement Regarding Ordinances. In lieu of judicial prosecution by the Village, any of the following described violations arising under the ordinances of the Village of Ringwood, Illinois, as amended, may be settled and compromised by the violator within the time hereinafter specified after service of the violation notice ticket by payment to the Village of Ringwood, Illinois, the sum of money herein set forth opposite such offense.

NOTE: In addition, the subject ordinance violation must be abated by such service date.

SECTION 2: All ordinances, or parts thereof, in conflict with the terms and provisions hereof, be and the same hereby are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form by and under the authority of the Corporate Authorities of the Village.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.
