VILLAGE OF RINGWOOD ORDINANCE NO. 17-12-19

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 406 OF THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF VILLAGE OF RINGWOOD

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF RINGWOOD, ILLINOIS, as follows:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. Section 406 is hereby amended to read as follows:

The outdoor storage and outdoor parking of commercial equipment and commercial vehicles is prohibited in Residential and Estate Zones created after the effective date of this Ordinance. This prohibition shall not apply to commercial vehicles and 83. The Village of Ringwood Zoning Ordinance equipment being temporarily used for the provision of a service, delivery or pickup for the benefit of a residence nor shall it apply to receptacles used for the collection of trash or recyclables. This prohibition shall not apply to commercial vehicles being used for agricultural purposes. Outdoor storage of boats, all types of watercraft, campers, recreation vehicles, motor homes, trailers of all types, all-terrain-vehicles and snowmobiles are prohibited in the A-1 Agricultural Zoning District (10 acres or less) R-1, RR-1, R-3, R-2, E-1 Residential Zoning Districts and also in the B-1, B-2, B-3, O/R, I-1 and I-2 Business and Industrial Zoning Districts in the Village of Ringwood. (Ord 5-5-1)

SECTION 2. Any person firm or corporation violating any portion of this Ordinance shall be fined not less than Fifty (\$50.00) and no more than Seven Hundred Fifty (\$750.00), for each offense committed on each day during, or on which a violation occurs or continues.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. All Ordinances or parts, or parts thereof, in conflict with the terms and provisions hereof, be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of any such conflict.

<u>SECTION 4</u>. This Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form by and under the authority of the corporate authorities of the Village.

<u>SECTION 5</u>. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, public, and pamphlet form, as provided by law.
