WHEREAS, on November 8, 1994 a referendum of the voters was held which resulted in the incorporation of the Village of Ringwood, Illinois; and,

WHEREAS, adequate funds are not available for the purpose of operating the Village government of the Village of Ringwood, Illinois; and,

WHEREAS, the Illinois Compiled Statutes, Chapter 35, Section 245/1-20 provides in part that before a County Clerk may extend taxes for funds subject to the limitations of the Illinois Municipal Code, a new taxing district shall hold a referendum establishing a maximum aggregate extension for the levy year.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF RINGWOOD, ILLINOIS, as follows:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> There shall be submitted to the voters of the Village of Ringwood, Illinois, on the 7th day of November, 1995, the following proposition:

"Under the	Property Tax Extension Limitation Act,	may an aggregate extension not
to exceed	\$36,000.00	be made for the Village of
Ringwood,	Illinois for the 1995 levy year?"	

<u>SECTION 2.</u> The aforesaid question shall be submitted to the voters in accordance with the Election Code in substantially the following manner:
