WHEREAS, on November 8, 1994 a referendum of the voters was held which resulted in the incorporation of the Village of Ringwood, Illinois; and,

WHEREAS, adequate funds are not available for the purpose of operating the Village government of the Village of Ringwood, Illinois; and,

WHEREAS, the Illinois Compiled Statutes, Chapter 35, Section 245/1-20 provides in part that before a County Clerk may extend taxes for funds subject to the limitations of the Illinois Municipal Code, a new taxing district shall hold a referendum establishing a maximum aggregate extension for the levy year.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF RINGWOOD, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION 1. There shall be submitted to the voters of the Village of Ringwood, Illinois, on the 7th day of November, 1995, the following proposition:

"Under the Property Tax Extension Limitation Act, may an aggregate extension not to exceed \$36,000.00 be made for the Village of Ringwood, Illinois for the 1995 levy year?"

SECTION 2. The aforesaid question shall be submitted to the voters in accordance with the Election Code in substantially the following manner:
