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AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 604.8 OF THE
VILLAGE SUBDIVISION ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE
VILLAGE OF RINGWOOD, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 604.8 of the Village Subdivision Ordinance is hereby amended by
adding thereto the following paragraph:

"The planting of the following species of trees on the road frontages
is hereby prohibited:

Acer negundo
A. saccharinum
Ailanthus altissima
Betula spp.
Catalpa speciosa
Elaeagnus spp.
Ginko biloba (female)
Macluna pomifera
Malus pumila
Morus spp.
Populus spp.

Box Elder
Silver Maple
Tree of Heaven
Birch
Caralpa
Russian Olive
Female Ginko
Osage Orange
Apple
Mulberry
Cottonwood, Poplar, Aspen

"C-9 OWNER'S NOTARIZED STATEMENT REGARDING SCHOOL DISTRICTS. The Owner shall submit simultaneously with the signed Subdivision Plat a notarized statement indicating to the best of the Owner's knowledge the school districts in which each tract, parcel, lot or block lies.

SECTION 3. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this ordinance shall be fined not less than Twenty Five Dollars (\$25.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each offense committed on each day during, or on which, a violation occurs or continues.

SECTION 4. All ordinances, or parts thereof, in conflict with the terms and provisions hereof, be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form by and under the authority of the Corporate Authorities of the Village.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.
