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AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 12-1008 OF THE
MOTOR VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC ORDINANCE
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BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE
VILLAGE OF RINGWOOD, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 12-1008 of the Village of Ringwood Motor Vehicle and Traffic
Ordinance is hereby amended by adding thereto the following provision as and for Section E thereof:

E. LIMITED LOAD STREETS. No vehicle or combination of
vehicles equipped with pneumatic tires shall be operated, unladen or
with load, upon the following named streets of the Village when the
gross weight on the road surface through any axle thereof exceeds
12,000 pounds:

1. School Road

An axle load shall be defined as the total load transmitted to the road
by all wheels whose centers may be included between two parallel

transverse vertical planes 40 inches apart extending across the full width of the vehicle.

Any two or more consecutive axles whose centers are more than 40 inches and not more than 72 inches apart, measured to the nearest inch between any two adjacent axles in the series, shall be defined as tandem axles, and the gross weight transmitted to the road surface through such series shall not exceed 24,000 pounds and no axle of the series shall exceed the maximum weight permitted under this section for a single axle.

It is unlawful to drive any such vehicle or combination of vehicles which is in excess of the above limitation on the streets named in this paragraph, except for the purpose of making delivery to or picking up a load from premises whose main access is by said street, in which case such vehicle may be driven on such street for not more than the minimum distance necessary for the purpose.

SECTION 2. Any person, firm, association, co-partnership or corporation convicted of any violation of paragraph E of Section 12-1008 of the Motor Vehicle and Traffic Ordinance of the Village of Ringwood shall be fined as provided in Section 12-1010 of the Motor Vehicle and Traffic Ordinance of the Village of Ringwood.

SECTION 3. All ordinances, or parts thereof, in conflict with the terms and provisions hereof, be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form by and under the authority of the Corporate Authorities of the Village.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.
