## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2-101 OF THE VILLAGE BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTION CODE

Published in pamphlet form by authority of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Ringwood, McHenry County, Illinois this 17th day of March, 2003.

> ORDINANCE NO. 03-1-1-AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2-101 OF THE VILLAGE BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTION CODE.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF RINGWOOD, MCHENRY COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION 1: Village of Ringwood Ordinance No. 96-7-3, entitled "Building and Construction" is hereby amended as follows:

> Section 2-101G thereof is hereby amended to read as follows: "The construction of drive-ways shall comply with the following minimum base and surface pavement requirements:

## MINIMUM BASE REQUIREMENT

MINIMUM SURFACE PAVEMENT REQUIREMENT

Residential Building Permit.

6"compacted aggregate base course shall 2: bituminous concret surface course OR be installed after foundation walls have 4" Portland cement concrete over been constructed and before any otehr reinforcing wire shall be installed within one work is commenced pursuant to the year after the date of the issuance of the Residential Building Permit.

Section 2-101 thereof is amended to add the following provision as Section 309.05 of "CABO One and Two Family Dwelling Code", 1995 Addition:

Section 309.05. THREE CAR GARAGE REQUIRED. detached one family dwelling shall have not less than a three-car garage.

Section 2-101Y thereof is amended by repealing the provisions thereof and by substituting the following provisions in the place thereof: CONSTRUCTION WASTE MATERIALS: Construction waste materials, rubbish and scraps shall not be allowed to become strewn over the construction site or adjacent properties, but shall be placed in a dumpster or snowfenced typed-enclosed waste collection dump site on the premises. The general contractor shall be required to clean up the construction site each day after work is completed.

<u>BURNING AND/OR BURYING OF SUCH MATERIALS IS HEREBY PROHIBITED:</u> All such materials shall be removed from the construction site before the Occupancy Permit may be granted to the premises.

<u>DAILY ROAD CLEAN UP</u>: The general contractor shall, each day, clean up all dirt, mud and other waste materials deposited on the roadway as a result of work performed on the premises.

SECTION 2: Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this ordinance shall be fined not less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars \$500.00) for each offense committed on each day during, or on which, a violation occurs or continues.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> All ordinances, or parts thereof, in conflict with the terms and provisions hereof, be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> This ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form by and under the authority of the Corporate Authorities of the Village.

<u>SECTION 5:</u> This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval according to law.
