ORDINANCE NO. 6-5-03 AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR NO PARKING ON A PORTION OF BARNARD MILL ROAD

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF RINGWOOD, ILLINOIS, as follows:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> No person shall park any motor vehicle on Barnard Mill Road between Ringwood Road and Van Buren Street for a period in excess of two hours of any day.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this ordinance shall be fined not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each offense committed on each day during, or on which, a violation occurs or continues.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> All ordinances, or parts thereof, in conflict with the terms and provisions hereof, be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> This ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form by and under the authority of the Corporate Authorities of the Village.

<u>SECTION 5</u>. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.
