ORDINANCE NO. 96-2-1-

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING LOUD AND REPEATED
BARKING, WHINING AND HOWLING BY DOGS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE
VILLAGE OF RINGWOOD, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to harbor or keep any dog which disturbs the peace of any person in the neighborhood by loud and repeated barking, whining, howling, or other sounds, at any time of the day or night. Such loud and repeated barking, whining, howling or other sounds are hereby declared to be a public nuisance.

SECTION 2. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this ordinance shall be fined not less than Twenty Five Dollars (\$25.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each offense committed on each day during, or on which, a violation occurs or continues.

SECTION 3. All ordinances, or parts thereof, in conflict with the terms and provisions hereof, be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.
