ORDINANCE NO. 97-7-2 ASCERTAINING PREVAILING WAGES IN THE VILLAGE OF RINGWOOD

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois has enacted "An Act regulating wages of laborers, mechanics and other workmen employed in any public works by the state, county, city or any other public body or any political subdivision or by any one under contract for public works:, approved June 26, 1941, as amended, (Ill. Rev. Stat. 1987, Ch. 48, par. 39s-1 et seq. as amended by Public Acts 86-799 and 86-693) and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid Act requires that the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Ringwood investigate and ascertain the prevailing rate of wages as defined in said Act for laborers, mechanics and other workers employed in performing construction of public works for said Village.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF RINGWOOD, MCHENRY COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION 1. To the extent and as required by an Act regulating wages of laborers, mechanics, and other workmen employed in any public works by the state, county, city or any public body or any political subdivision or by anyone under contract for public works, approved June 26, 1941, as amended, the general prevailing rate of wages in this locality for laborers, mechanics and other workers engaged in construction of public works coming under the jurisdiction of the Village is hereby ascertained to be the same as the prevailing rate of wages for construction work and repair of existing facilities in the McHenry County area as determined by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois as of September 1, 1997, a copy of that determination being attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. As required by said Act, any and all revisions of the prevailing rate of wages by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois of the State of the State of Illinois of the State of

Illinois shall supersede the Department's June determination and apply to any and all public works construction undertaken by the Village. The definition of any terms appearing in this Ordinance which are also used in the aforesaid Act shall be the same as in said Act.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> Nothing herein contained shall be construed to apply said prevailing rate of wages as herein ascertained to any work or employment except public works construction and the repair of existing facilities of this Village to the extent required by the aforesaid Act.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> The Village Clerk shall publicly post or keep available for inspection by any interested party in the main office of this Village this determination or any revisions of such prevailing rate of wage. A copy of this determination or of the current revised determination of prevailing rate of wages then in effect shall be attached to contract specifications.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> The Village Clerk shall mail a copy of this determination to any employer, and to any association of employers and to any person or association of employees who have filed, or file their names and addresses requesting copies of any determination stating the particular rates and the particular class of workmen whose wages will be affected by such rates.

<u>SECTION 5.</u> The Village Clerk shall promptly file a certified copy of this Ordinance with both the Secretary of State Index Division and the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois.

<u>SECTION 6.</u> The Village clerk shall cause to be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the area a copy of this Ordinance, and such publication shall constitute notice that the determination is effective and that this is the determination of this public body.
