ORDINANCE NO. 98-11- 4
THE ANNUAL TAX LEVY ORDINANCE
OF THE VILLAGE OF RINGWOOD, ILLINOIS
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING MAY 1, 1998 AND ENDING APRIL 30, 1999

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Ringwood, McHenry County, Illinois,
did on the 15th day of June, 1998, pass the Annual Appropriation Ordinance for the said Village
for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 1998 and ending April 30, 1999, and

WHEREAS, said Ordinance was approved by the President of the Village on the 15th
day of June, 1998, the amount of which is ascertained to be the aggregate sum of Three
Hundred Sixteen Thousand Four Hundred fifty-six Dollars and Zero Cents (\$316,456).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF
TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF RINGWOOD, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION 1. That thereby and is hereby levied upon all of the taxable property within
the corporate limits of the Village of Ringwood, Illinois, subject to taxation for the year 1998, the
sum of thirty-seven Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$37,000.00) for the following specific
purposes designated in said Appropriation Ordinance and in the respective sums as follows:

SECTION 2. All unexpended balances of any item or items of any general appropriation made by this Ordinance may be expended in making up any insufficiency in any items in the same general appropriation and for the same general purpose or in a like appropriation made by this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. This Levy Ordinance is adopted pursuant to procedures set forth in the Illinois Municipal Code, provided, however, that any limitations in the Illinois Municipal code in Conflict with this Ordinance shall not be applicable to this Ordinance, pursuant to Section 6 of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form by and under the authority of the corporate authorities of the Village of Ringwood.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and approval and publication in pamphlet form, according to law.
