REFUSE

Flood Bros. Disposal Co. will provide each single-family, two-unit properties with a 95-gallon refuse carts for weekly collection. Additional carts are available for those residents that would be interested; a rental price of \$3.00 per unit per month would be applied. Any refuse that cannot fit into the Flood Bros. issued cart must be placed in a bag or container not to exceed 35-gallons or 50lbs.

RECYCLING

Flood Bros. will provide each household with 65-gallon recycling carts. Residents have option to upgrade to 95-gallon recycling cart. Additional carts are available for those residents that would be interested; a rental price of \$3.00 per unit per month would be applied.

Flood Bros. will allow recycling materials to be co-mingled (i.e. plastic, glass, metal and paper products mixed together). Preparation requirements for households participating in the recycling program including rinsing, removing labels, flattening, removing caps, and lids, etc. can be found on our website.

YARD WASTE

Flood Bros. Disposal Co. will provide weekly collection of yard waste from April 1st through November 30th on the same day as refuse and recycling collection each week.

Yard waste is limited to eight (8) bags or cans per week. 95-gallon carts are available for those residents that would be interested in for an additional monthly fee. Residents that are interested in placing more than 8 bags/cans per week can subscribe to our annual yard waste subscription program. Please contact our office to arrange subscription service.

All yard waste shall be placed in a plastic or metal container with a tight cover, or a biodegradable Kraft bag, of a size no larger than 35-gallons and not exceeding 50lbs or a Flood Bros. issued yard waste cart.

We will accept and collect all bundles of brush or limbs, providing the bundles do not exceed a weight of fifty (50) pounds per bundle, are not more than four (4) feet long, are not more than two (2) feet in diameter, do not contain limbs greater than three (3) inches in diameter and are tied with a material that is accepted at the compost site.

BULK ITEMS

As part of the regularly scheduled refuse collection, Flood Bros will collect two (2) bulk items per week on refuse collection day at no charge. Additional bulk items are \$8.00 per item. An example, the following items are considered bulk items: mattresses, box springs, tables, chairs, chairs, and other furniture. Bulk items weighing over 50 pounds require special pick-up. Please call Flood Bros. to schedule.

CHRISTMAS TREE COLLECTION

Flood Bros. will provide a special collection for Christmas trees January 1st through 15th.

WHITE GOODS

Flood Bros. Disposal Co. will also provide collection services for white good items (i.e. appliances). White goods will be charged \$30.00 per item collected. Examples shall include refrigerators, dish washers, water heaters, washers, dryers, etc. Appliances: refrigerator, freezer, air conditioner, dishwasher, hot water heater, etc. We ask that you remove the doors from any refrigerator and freezer. After the items are collected, Freon is safely removed (if present) and appliances are recycled. Appliances must be empty. Residents will be asked to call our office 24 hours prior to collection to schedule the pickup.

CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS

Small amounts of “Do It Yourself” projects less than 50lbs will be collected for a fee of \$15.75 per yard with minimum of two yards. Anything greater call the office to schedule a special collection. Construction debris must be container in either cans or plastic bags not exceeding 35 gallons in size and 50 pounds in weight. Construction and remodeling debris that cannot be

containerized must be securely tied and bundled. Bundles must not exceed 4 feet in length and 50lbs in weight. Flood Bros. has roll off dumpsters available for rental for larger volumes of construction debris.

COLLECTION DAYS

All materials (refuse, recycling and yard waste) will be collected on the same day, once per week on **Wednesday**.

ELECTRONICS RECYCLING

Flood Bros. will offer an annual collection for approved electronics. Details on this event will be provided annually by the Village and Flood Bros.

The U.S. Environment Protection Agency states electronic waste is now the fastest growing segment of our nation’s waste. Electronic waste, from computers to TVs, contain toxic materials such as lead, chromium, cadmium, mercury, beryllium, nickel, zinc, and other potentially harmful chemicals. The EPA warns when electronics that contain these materials are not recycled or are not disposed of properly; the hazardous chemicals can contaminate the ground water and present additional environmental concerns.

STATE BAN

The State of Illinois electronic waste landfill ban is now a state law. Under this state law, electronic waste cannot be collected with household refuse/waste.
