## **Public Works Report**

Your Village officials are always looking and thinking of ways to improve Ringwood. We believe that even small improvements can make a big difference. The next two recently completed projects are good examples of those efforts.

**Ringwood Road Safety/Streetscape Project:** This spring, the Village Board hired Upland Construction and Maintenance to constructed a landscape island on Ringwood Road right-of-way in front of the Rusty Nail. The purpose of this streetscape project was to address

a potential safety issue in this area. This improvement will prevent the front end of vehicles from hanging over into the east bound lane of Ringwood Road. It will also improve the overall visibility for those driving on Ringwood Road and for those entering and leaving the Rusty Nail parking lot. In addition to improving safety, this project was designed to be a streetscape project that would improve the overall appearance of this area.

**Decorative Street Signs** - This spring the Village installed our standard decorative street signs in the Country Crossings and Oakview Estates subdivisions. Per Village requirements, the developer of Glacial Trails installed the decorative street signs in that subdivision.

**Other 2024 infrastructure projects** - The Village Board hired contractors to complete the following work:

- · Crack fill South Ridgeway Road
- Crack fill, seal coat and stripe the Village Hall parking lot
- Stripe the Barnard Mill and Ringwood Roads Prairie Trail crosswalks
- Repair a drainage issue on the sidewalk near Doggie Style Grooming
- Repair a culvert on Ringwood Road east of the intersection of Route 31 and Ringwood Road.

## **April 2024**

• Approve Village Presidents Rick Mack's appointment of Elaine Fung to the position of Village Clerk.

All Trustees were present at the April Village Board meeting and voted unanimously to approve the above action.

## May 2024

- Approve Licensing agreement between Everstream GLC Holding Company and the Village of Ringwood.
- Approve amending the plat of subdivision for the Pioneer Oaks of Ringwood subdivision to change the name of Justen Lane to Justen Farm Lane.
- Approve Appropriations for corporate purposes for fiscal year beginning May 1, 20024 and ending April 30, 2025.
- · Approve annual Business Registration ordinance.
- Approve an ordinance amending Section 3-11, Driveways of chapter 3 building code and building regulations.
- Approve amending Article 6. Design and construction of roads and roadside drainage facilities of the Ringwood subdivision ordinance.
- Approve FY2024/2025 General Engineering Consultant contract between HR Green and the Village of Ringwood.

All Trustees were present at the May Village Board meeting and voted unanimously to approve the above action.

#### June 2024

- Approve Professional Services Agreement between the Village of Ringwood and HR Green for FY 2024/2025 for building plan reviewed and inspection services.
- Deny request from Cultivate Power for conditional use and various variances for two solar farms.

All Trustees were present at the June Village Board meeting and voted unanimously to approve the above action.

## **July 2024**

- Approve hiring Pavement Solutions LLC to perform thermoplastic striping of Ringwood and Barnard Mill crosswalks and to crack fill South Ridgeway Road.
- Approve hiring B&B Coatings CO. to crack fill, seal coat and stripe the Village Hall Parking lot.
- Approve hiring Upland Construction and Maintenance to repair and replace the sidewalk and curb near Doggie Style Grooming to resolve drainage issue that results in water ponding on sidewalk.
- Approve hiring Upland Construction and Maintenance to repair culvert on Ringwood Road just east of the interaction of Route 31 and Ringwood Road.

All Trustees present at the July Village Board meeting and voted unanimously to approve the above action, except Trustee Morgan who was absent.

## Possible Future Action by the Village Board

- · Consider Levy Ordinance.
- · Consider updates and variances to the Village Zoning ordinance.
